Zacharias and Prager represent clear-headed, Judeo-Christian ethics that have guided our nation for nearly 250 years. Zacharias is founder of RZIM based in Atlanta, Georgia. Zacharias has spent the past 45 years commending the Christian faith and addressing life’s great existential questions of origin, meaning, morality, and destiny with eloquence and grace. His radio program, “Let my People Think” is aired on 100.7 FM Saturday’s at 1:30 p.m. ET. He has authored or edited more than 25 books in the fields of theology, apologetics, comparative religion, and philosophy. Zacharias and his wife, Margie, have been married for 45 years and have three grown children.

Dennis Prager is one of America’s most respected radio talk show hosts. He has been broadcasting on radio in Los Angeles since 1982. His popular show became nationally syndicated in 1999 and airs live, Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. PT on KZNT 1460 AM and 101.1 FM. For ten years, he conducted a weekly interfaith dialogue on radio with representatives of virtually every religion in the world. New York’s Jewish Week described Dennis Prager as “one of the three most interesting minds in American Jewish Life.” In 2011, Prager co-founded with Allen Estrin, Prager University, an institution of higher learning on the Internet with a unique difference – all the courses

are five minutes long. Prager University videos have since garnered more than 2 billion views.

The mission of Summit Ministries is to cultivate rising generations to resolutely champion a biblical worldview. Its programming consists of two-week conferences for 16 to 25-year-olds in multiple locations across the U.S. It also offers semester-long programs for collegiate-level students.
