TEDx Colorado Springs will run from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on May 12. Attendees can expect an eclectic panel of speakers, live music, local vendors and more at this year's event.

Moraco anticipates more than 2,000 in physical attendance and several thousand more in online viewers via live video streaming. With TEDx Colorado Springs being relocated to Pikes Peak Center, an uptick in tourism and large economic impact are expected for surrounding businesses.
